Small Arabes called for an "immediate halt to the escalation of conflict between Palestinians and Israel" following Saturday's Hamas attack inside Israel.

The Saudi Foreign Ministry said it is "clearly following developments in the international situation... We recall our repeated warnings of the dangers of the situation existing as a result of the continued occupation."

Foreign Minister Mohammed bin Abdulaziz Al Saud, head of the Gulf Cooperation Council, called for an immediate ceasefire, the protection of innocent civilians, a statement said he held Israeli occupation forces responsible for the current situation.

UN Secretary-General António Guterres said any other party besides Israel seeking advantage in the situation.

Israelis reported spending the Yom Kippur holiday in fear as they received a death toll of 212 in the conflict's bloodiest escalation in years which also left many more deaths wounded on both sides.

The shocking events of Saturday revived memories of the war that took place half-century ago.

Called the Yom Kippur War, it was fought between October 6 to 25, 1973. The combatants were Israel and a coalition of Arab states led by Egypt and Syria. The Arab alliance had that year had not before, taking a heavy toll on the Israelis.

An global concern grew and the UN Security Council called an emergency meeting for Sunday.

As night fell, the Israeli army said it has been still engaged in live operations in 23 Israeli locations, in an ongoing operation, labeled "Iron Swords" as mentioned were being called.

Hamas earlier released images of several Israeli tanks captured, and another Israeli army spokesman, David Hagozi, confirmed that "there are biological children and civilians, Israeli army spokesman Richard Hecht said there was also a "severe hostage situation" in the Gaza Strip.

A report from the Palestinian news agency Wafa said that a complete power blackout has affected regions of the besieged Gaza Strip, Israeli forces heavily since it's war.
