# First 3 Beasts

**Daniel 7:1-6** *In the first year of Belshazzar king of Babylon [between Chapters 4 and 5] I, Daniel saw a dream and visions in his mind as he lay on his bed then he wrote the dream down and this summary of it*

**Remember** Naboplassar's son Nebuchadnezzar son-in-law Nabonidus son Belshazzar Nabonidus abroad near Arabia and Sinai peninsula - Belshazzar in Babylon *handwriting on the wall*

**Prophetically "Times of the Gentiles"** *Luke 21:24 Jerusalem trampled until then*

**"Times" of Gentiles** *still going on now – started with Babylonian captivity*

**Babylon-MedoPersia-Greece-Rome . . . Diaspora**

**"Fullness" of Gentiles** *future completion of Gentile world - then 70<sup>th</sup> Shabua for Israel*

# The 4<sup>th</sup> Beast

I kept looking in the night visions - behold a 4<sup>th</sup> beast **dreadful and terrifying and extremely strong with large iron teeth** - it consumed "pulverized to powder" and trampled down

the remainder [prior 3 beasts] with its feet - different from all beasts before it - it had **10 horns**

NOTE: No 'animal' comparative-imagery Iron back to Daniel 2:40-43 statue dream

Rome trampled all other peoples-cultures under its identity [also **verse-19**]

Rome definitely unique from prior Empires

**10 horns ARE 10 kings verse-24**

# Interpret this Vision

Daniel 7:15-22

Then I desired to know the exact meaning of the 4<sup>th</sup> beast [infers Daniel understood the first 3 beasts – this one's unique]

which was different from all the others exceedingly dreadful with teeth of iron and claws of bronze - which devoured, crushed, and trampled down the remainder with its feet - and the meaning of the 10 horns that were on its head and the other [II<sup>th</sup>] horn which came up before which three of them fell, namely, that horn which had eyes and a mouth uttering great boasts [Daniel knew this prior verse-8] which was larger in appearance than its associates - I kept looking and that [II<sup>th</sup>] horn was waging war with the saints and overpowering them [remnant Jews]

Rev. 13:7 antichrist makes war with the saints and overcomes them [remnant Jews]

Zech. 13:8-9 two-thirds cut off and perish, but one-third will remain

Matt. 16:18 the gates of Hades will never overcome the church
